EXCERPTS FROM THE CHAMBER ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REVIEW STUDY GROUP

As reported by President-Elect Gil Stromsoe, "The chamber recommends support of the Caruso Project on a mainly economic basis."

The report concluded that the traffic would actually be improved after the project opens due to \$ 10 million that the developer will contribute to state of the art traffic mitigation and street improvements.

The development, as described in the report, offers extraordinary benefits to the city, with a projected minimum net of \$2.2 million in annual sales tax revenue increase and to the school district by providing 40 years of 22,000-square-foot of rent-free office space.

In addition, it will free up space for the high school's expansion.
